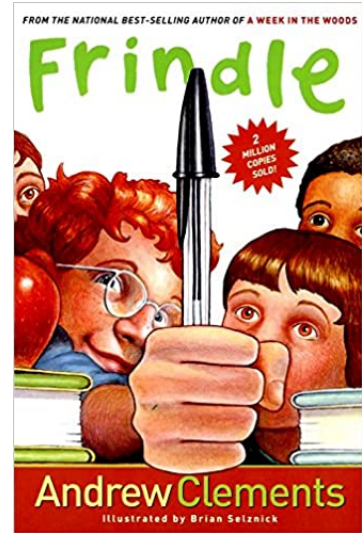


## Camp 2: July 11-15 (grades 3-5)

## Online Summer Camp

**Students will enhance their comprehension, improve vocabulary and writing skills as they:**

- *critically* analyze chapters of a novel daily
- respond to questions in complete sentences
- cite effective evidence to support answers
- learn new vocabulary and improve grammar
- study symbols authors use; what do they mean?
- identify and explain the themes of the novel

**The camp is taught by Ms. Galdenzi, a certified teacher. Each day, students will:**

- attend a Zoom class from 9:30 AM to 12:00 PM
- read and discuss parts of the novel together
- complete a written comprehension activity
- submit a writing assignment connected to the novel
- review the previous day's assignment
- complete 30-40 minutes of homework for feedback
