Exposing the truth at any cost -- *Most Dangerous*



This is a 2-week camp due to the length of the book.

In the 1960s, the United States and the Soviet Union were fighting for global leadership. Vietnam was a battleground where the two nations could confront each other without risking a nuclear war that would destroy the planet.

Daniel Ellsberg was one of the planners who guided the American war effort in Vietnam. While American Presidents sought to assure the American people - and themselves - that the United States was winning, Ellsberg knew the war was going badly - and could only end in disaster. Has Ellsberg the right to reveal the truth to the people of the United States - and become the 'most dangerous man in America'?

Most Dangerous asks a question just as relevant today: how much should a democratic government keep secret from its people?

Online Summer Camp

Students will enhance their comprehension, improve vocabulary and writing skills as they:

- learn about the historical era of the book
- *critically* analyze chapters of a novel daily
- respond to questions in complete sentences
- cite evidence to support answers
- learn new vocabulary and improve grammar
- study symbols authors use; what do they mean?
- identify and explain the themes of the novel

The camp is taught by Mr. Keery, a professional author and Certified Teacher with 30 years of experience. Each day, students will:

- attend a Zoom class from 9:30 AM to 12:00 PM
- read and discuss parts of the novel together
- complete a written comprehension activity
- submit a writing assignment connected to the novel
- review the previous day's assignment
- complete 30-40 minutes of homework for feedback
