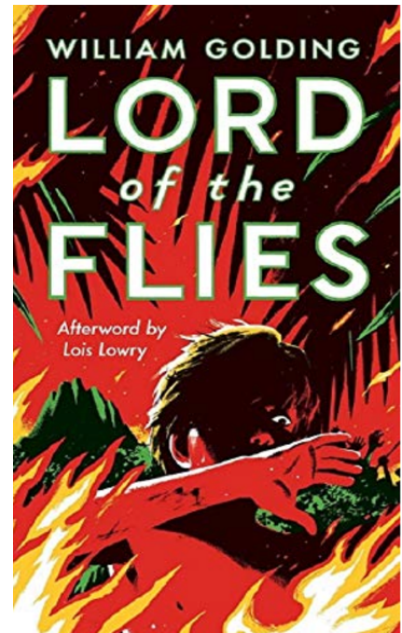


Camp 4: August 8 - 12, 2022 (target grades 8-10)

A fateful choice -- Lord of the Flies

The classic adventure tale of a group of British schoolboys marooned on a tropical island, far away from any adult supervision or any of the ethics, values and traditions of modern society.

Cut off and alone, the boys gradually descend into savagery and allow their darker, baser natures to emerge. The novel's bleak look at human nature is even more relevant today, as social media technology cuts us off from each other and leads many people down that same dark path. Will we heed the lessons of the Lord of the Flies?

Online Summer Camp

Students will enhance their comprehension, improve vocabulary and writing skills as they:

- learn about the historical era of the book
- *critically* analyze chapters of a novel daily
- respond to questions in complete sentences
- cite evidence to support answers
- learn new vocabulary and improve grammar
- study symbols authors use; what do they mean?
- identify and explain the themes of the novel

The camp is taught by Mr. Keery, a professional author and Certified Teacher with 30 years of experience. Each day, students will:

- attend a Zoom class from 9:30 AM to 12:00 PM
- read and discuss parts of the novel together
- complete a written comprehension activity
- submit a writing assignment connected to the novel
- review the previous day's assignment
- complete 30-40 minutes of homework for feedback
